TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH BFA/21
(FAIRFORD TOWN) COTSWOLD DISTRICT

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council has made an Order to close temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) part of Public Footpath BFA/21 from its junction with public footpath BFA/44 at Dilly's Bridge to Public Footpath BFA/23 for a distance of approximately 600 metres.

The closure is necessary to resurface the path.

The footpath falls within Fairford Town in the Cotswold District, in the County of Gloucestershire.

The Order will come into force at 08:00 hours on the 15th April 2019 and it is anticipated that the public right of way will close on that day until 17:00 hours on the 31st May 2019. However should it be necessary to continue the closure for longer than this period the Order can authorise the closure for up to six months. After this date if the closure is still required it will be necessary to apply to the Secretary of State for an extension of time.
